The Macmillan/Oldham Citizens Advice Bureau **Help with the Costs of Cancer Service** provides free, confidential and impartial advice on welfare benefits and other sources of financial help to people affected by cancer.

We can:

- help you with the full range of welfare benefits, eg Income Support, Housing Benefit, Social Fund grants, Carer's Allowance, Disability Living Allowance, bereavement payments including Inland Revenue tax credits
- provide advice, support and advocacy with benefit reviews and appeals
- help with health costs, eg Hospital Travel Scheme
- advise about disability exemptions, eg Council Tax reduction
- help you apply for charitable grants and payments eg Family Fund
- tell you about financial help from local authorities, eg school clothing grants and other sources, eg transport concessions.

We can also make internal referrals to other services within Oldham District CAB for clients who have other issues concerning budgeting, debt, housing, employment and immigration.
